Cabernet Sauvignon

he Domaine Sonoma Winery and Vineyards are located in Healdsburg, Russian River Valley, Sonoma County, California at a site that was homesteaded in 1852 and where grapes were first planted in 1928. In 1973 new ownership transformed the former rustic winery to one that conforms to the highest standards of modern CA winemaking. Our vineyards are meticulously cared for and provide our winemaker Steve Fredson (fifth generation of a winemaking family) with exceptional fruit that highlight the special qualities that Russian River Valley has to offer.

2019 Cabernet Sauvignon Sonoma County

Ninety percent of our 2019 Cabernet is sourced right from our own backyard at the winery, with the remaining 10% from our neighboring growers. We are located in the warmer region of Russian River appellation on a western facing slope which provided maximum sun exposure to develop color and tannin structure. The wine is 100% Cabernet, with 80% from our hillside vineyard which provides tannin and structure, Aged 8 months in American Oak.

Tasting notes:

Intense color; berry fruit aromas; classic Cabernet depth of flavor with hints of spice and pepper; oak complexity and a smooth finish.
